Below are the following requirements to qualify in the OWWA scholarship program:

- 1. Must be a qualified dependent of active OFW members;
- 2. Must be 4<sup>th</sup> year high school student belonging to the upper 20% of the graduating class; and
- 3. Must pass the qualifying DOST Examination (only the top 200 will be considered);
