The Philippine Embassy is pleased to announce that the Office of the Representative of the Philippine Social Security System (SSS) in Bahrain is now open and ready to accept application for Data Capture for the Unified Multi-Purpose ID (UMID). SSS members who do not have SSS ID may now apply for UMID Data Capture at the SSS Office at the Embassy from 8:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M.

Requirements for Unified Multi-Purpose ID (UMID) Data Capture:

- 1. Must be an SSS actively paying member;
- 2. Fill up SSS Form E-6 using black or blue ink pen and supply needed information;
- 3. Present copy of at least two valid IDs (Passport copy, Philippine Driver's License, PRC, Voter's ID, CPR);
- 4. Proceed with the screening and Data Capture.

Card Replacement (Lost SSS ID, Data Amendment, UMID):

- 1. Must pay Php300.00 using the form R-6 as replacement fee through their relative in the Philippines and present a copy of the validated payment receipt;
- 2. Fill up SSS Form E-6, supply needed information and thick on "Card Replacement" and write the reason for replacement;
- Present at least two (2) valid IDs (Passport Copy, Philippine Driver's License, PRC, Voter's ID, CPR);
- 4. Proceed with screening and Data Capture.

Release of UMID Card:

After capturing the data, UMIDs will be processed in the Philippines and will be sent back to Bahrain. Release of UMIDs may take longer. Applicants are advised to contact first the SSS Representative, Mr. Edre Bayno, through his mobile no. +973 36906218 before going to the Embassy to receive the UMID card.

To avoid rejection of UMID application, applicants are advised to clean their fingers for clear capture of finger prints. Wearing of contact lenses, sleeveless shirts/blouses, dangling earing are also not allowed during data capture.
