Manama, Bahrain – The Philippine Embassy in Manama, Kingdom of Bahrain in coordination with the Bahrain Specialist Hospital (BSH) conducted a Workshop on Hands-Only Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) on Friday, 23 March 2019, from 9:00 A.M. to 11:00 A.M. at the Embassy lobby. BSH is a JCI accredited hospital and is an authorized training center of the American Heart Association.

As part of the Embassy's activities for Women's Month, the training aims to develop the capacity of its personnel and dependent family members to respond to emergency situations that may occur at home, in the workplace or anywhere else.

Ms. Sasikala Sasikumar and Mr. John Christopher Rosauro, licensed Basic Life-Saver Instructors of BSH, were the Resource Persons of the workshop. They discussed and demonstrated emergency situations which may require basic life-saving methods through hands-only CPR. Participants were given the opportunity to practice these life-saving skills through dummy patients.
