10 April 2019 – In observance of World Health Day 2019, the Philippine Embassy in Manama, Kingdom of Bahrain, in coordination with the Bahrain Specialist Hospital (BSH) conducted a special health awareness program at the Embassy lobby on Sunday, 07 April 2019.

Medical staff of the BSH provided free blood pressure checking and blood sugar testing to the Embassy's personnel as well as to applicants and visitors of the Embassy.
