

8 March 2020 - The Philippine Embassy in Manama, Kingdom of Bahrain joins the worldwide celebration of International Women's Day by implementing the Serbisyo Para Kay Juana program wherein a special lane at the consular section of the Embassy was made available exclusively for women passport applicants on 8 March

2020. OWWA Bahrain also provided its clients of free hygiene kits throughout the day to mark the celebration.

The Serbisyo Para kay Juana lane was able to process and accept a total of thirty-six (36) applications for passport renewal during the day. Now on its 4th year, the successful staging of Serbisyo Para Kay Juana project as a means of raising awareness on gender issues among Embassy clients has been noteworthy as women clients served during the day were elated of the gesture that made them feel value.
