12 August 2018 – The Philippine Embassy inform Filipinos in Bahrain that the Ateneo De Manila University has announced that college applications for school year 2019-2020 is now open for interested students from the Middle East.

Starting this year, Ateneo De Manila University admission and scholarship application forms are available for download online from the school website at acet.ateneo.edu/APPLY. The Embassy encourages incoming freshman applicants in Bahrain, those who are currently taking or have already finished Grade 12, to submit their applications to the nearest International Testing Center from July 30 to 24 September 2018.

The Ateneo College Entrance Test (ACET) in Bahrain will be administered on 29 September 2018 at 9:00 am to 2:00 pm at the Philippine School Bahrain. Attached are the guidelines for International Freshman Applicants for the Middle East. Applicants who cannot be in the Philippines to take the ACET may opt to submit their International Baccalaureate (IB) Predicted Scores, IB Diploma, or Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) results in lieu of taking the ACET.

GUIDELINES FOR INTERNATIONAL TRANSFER APPLICANTS FROM THE MIDDLE EAST
SY 2019-2020

Applicants living and/or studying outside the Philippines are considered international applicants.

A. DURING APPLICATION

All applicants from the United Arab Emirates, Qatar, Bahrain, and Kingdom of Saudi Arabia may apply for admission into the Ateneo de Manila University either by (1) taking the Ateneo College Entrance Test (ACET) in Bahrain, Doha, Dubai, Riyadh, or Al Khobar; or by (2) submitting their Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) results taken within the last two years.

B. APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Visit the application website (acet.ateneo.edu/APPLY).
2. Download the application kit, fill out the application form and accomplish all requirements.
3. Pay the non-refundable application and testing fee of PHP 2,500 or USD 50 (international applicants).
4. Register for the Ateneo College Entrance Test (ACET) at Ateneo de Manila University to get your exam permit.
5. Take the ACET at the Ateneo de Manila University, Philippines. The ACET is a test requirement for admission to the undergraduate program of the Loyola Schools of the Ateneo de Manila University. This half-day test covers the areas of Mathematics, English, and General Intelligence.
6. Submit all application requirements via courier to:

 - Philippines
7. Wait for the decision on your application.
