Other Philippine products featured during the *Fiesta* were condiments, noodles, snack items, and cooked Filipino food such as *chicken empanada*, *laing* (*dried gabi leaves with coconut milk*), *adobong pusit*, *lumpiang shanghai*, and Philippine delicacies like *turon*, *puto*, *kutsinta*, as well as desserts including *buko pandan*, Pinoy-style macaroni salad and *buko* (*coconut*) salad.
