The blood donation and medical mission activities included general medical check-up, eye check-up, and blood sugar testing. PIN also conducted Hands-On CPR Training (Basic Life Saving Technique or Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation) from 1:00 P.M. to 4:00 P.M. Participants who joined in the said training also supported the fundraising campaign that sold PIN's Medical Mission T-shirts. The proceeds of the fundraiser will be given to selected beneficiaries, including Filipino patients who are suffering from terminal illnesses.
